

Sample Menu of Common Area Corrections
<ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>▪ Use a proximity correction</li><li>▪ Give a gentle verbal reprimand—Some types include:<ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>Quick: Use a “one liner”</li><li>Instructional</li><li>Humorous</li><li>Appeal to relationship</li></ul></li><li>▪ Keep a record of the behavior</li><li>▪ Written notification to teacher</li><li>▪ Assign a time out—“Stay right there for 30 seconds.”</li><li>▪ Assign a time out in a specified location</li><li>▪ Time out with supervisor: “Stay with me for one minute.”</li><li>▪ Have student fill out a “Behavior Improvement Form”</li><li>▪ Require restitution by the student (e.g., apology, go aback and walk</li><li>▪ Issue a demerit in cafeteria or playground (3 demerits equals one to three days of:<ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>Recess 101 with a highly skilled assistant</li><li>Restricted area or assigned table</li><li>Assigned to work with counselor</li><li>Work detail</li></ul></li><li>▪ Referral</li></ul>
